



NCURA REGION III POSITION DESCRIPTION

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR

A. FUNCTION OF THE POSITION

Develops methods to recruit and retain volunteers at the regional and national level and plans networking activities at NCURA sponsored meetings.

B. RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinate with Executive Committee and Committee Coordinators to identify volunteer opportunities.
- Coordinate with Committee Coordinators to recruit volunteers.
- Oversee volunteer activities at the annual Regional and National Meetings to ensure coverage of all positions
- Maintain a database of members interested in volunteering.
- Provide information/reports to NCURA National Organization as required.
- Coordinate with Website Coordinator to select volunteer of the month for recognition on the website.
- Assess the volunteer experience at NCURA meetings.
- Other duties as agreed upon.

C. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a regular member in good standing of NCURA (as referenced in National Bylaws).
- Must be a current member of Region III.

D. TERM LENGTH AND LIMITS

- Serves a term of one (1) year beginning after the annual Regional Meeting.
- Eligible for one (1) additional term at the discretion of the Chair-Elect.
- May not serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.

E. REPORTING LINES

- Reports to the Chair-Elect.

F. TIME COMMITMENT

- Time required to fulfill responsibilities is approximately four (4) hours per month with additional time before the Regional and National meetings.
- Attends both the annual Regional Meeting and the annual National Meeting, or assigns a designee from the committee to attend.
- Participates in Volunteer Coordinator conference calls scheduled by the National Organization.

G. BENEFITS AND PRIVILEGES

- Professional development and recognition within NCURA regionally and nationally.

H. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Attendance is required at the Regional and National Meetings. Reimbursement of travel expenses is not available.
